

Foundation Institute Continuing Education Seminars – 2014

Foundation Institute, Center for Biblical Education, is pleased to announce that registration is now open for two continuing education seminars to be held at the headquarters office this coming summer. Based upon the interest we received last summer, we believe we will be able to offer two sessions this summer.

Each of the seminars will be identical and will offer approximately 30 class-hours of instruction provided by Foundation Institute instructors and administrators. The majority of the instruction will be drawn directly from the Scripture, while the remainder will focus on practical application of biblical principles.

The seminars, which are open to all adults who attend Church of God, a Worldwide Association, are scheduled for the weeks of July 7-11 and July 21-25. Tuition for each seminar will be the same as last year—\$75 for the first person in each family and \$50 for each additional person. This will cover all classroom expenses and will also include lunch and refreshments each day for all participants.

Classes will be held at the headquarters office, in the Foundation Institute classroom, so space is limited and we must restrict each session to approximately 25 participants.

Participants will need to make their own arrangements for housing, breakfast and dinner. There are a number of reasonably priced hotels and restaurants in the area.

This summer we are also able to offer a special housing arrangement for any who may be interested. Since we will not be using the student housing during the summer, we can offer dormitory-style rooms to those who might wish to stay there. There are two two-bedroom apartments available. Each bedroom has twin beds and its own bathroom. Those staying at the apartments would need to provide their own linens and would be expected to leave the apartment clean when they leave. The apartments offer basic furniture, dishes, appliances and cooking utensils, and also have a washer and dryer. They do not have televisions or Internet service. The cost for the rooms would be \$40 per night for each bedroom. These apartments are on the second floor, and there are no elevators available. If any would like to reserve one of these rooms, they will be available on a first-come, first served basis.

Participants may register for the seminars in one of two ways:

You will then need to send a check for tuition. Registration is not complete until we receive your tuition.
